

# Saturn

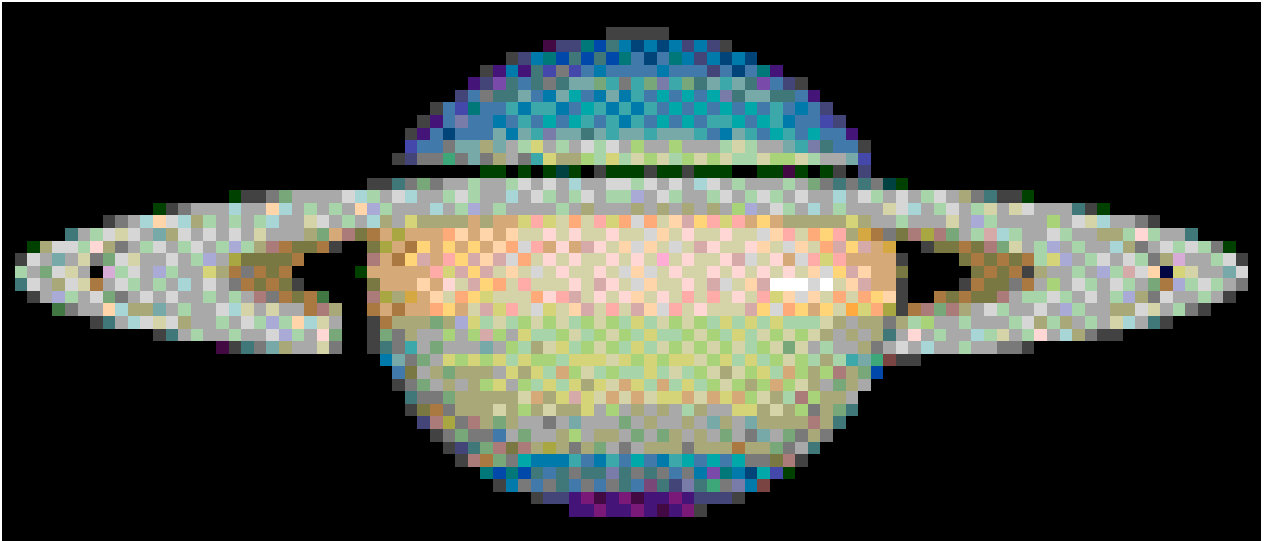
