Definition of a Foundation

An educational foundation is a non-governmental, non-profit organization having a money fund of its own, managed by its own trustees, and established to maintain or aid educational activities, programs, and projects.

Why a Foundation for Richland School District?

The traditional sources of income for the public schools (property tax and state aid) no longer meet all the needs of a school district. The establishment of a foundation by a public school district appears to be a logical activity to supplement traditional revenue sources.
