

WHAT TO DO IF YOUR CHILD HAS BEEN EXCLUDED FROM SCHOOL DUE TO COVID-LIKE SYMPTOMS OR ACTUAL/POTENTIAL EXPOSURE

IF YOUR CHILD IS EXPERIENCING THE FOLLOWING - SEEK EMERGENCY CARE (911)

- Trouble breathing
- Persistent pain/pressure in chest
- New confusion

- Inability to wake or stay awake
- Blue lips or face Uncontrolled fevers
- Healthcare Provider visit: CALL AHEAD to schedule an appointment to avoid large groups waiting
- Free COVID-19 Testing: Call Public Health Department or check Department of Health Services (DHS) website for locations and times
- Follow Public Health/School guidelines for quarantine/isolation periods for household members

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KNOWN EXPOSURE (Contact Public Health for any quarantine/isolation questions) o May return to school when the following are met:

TEST NEGATIVE FOR COVID

- <u>All:</u> Quarantine for 14 days after last day of contact with COVID-19 positive person (or per Public Health guidelines)
- · IF SYMPTOMS:
 - o 24 hours fever-free with no fever reducing medicine
 - o <u>IF diagnosed</u> with OTHER illness (i.e. Strep) also follow provider instructions specific to that illness (Need Provider note)
- Proof of NEGATIVE COVID test. (SEE OPTIONS BELOW)
- <u>Test result is only accurate for the date</u> <u>you were tested</u>

NOT TESTED FOR COVID

- <u>All:</u> Quarantine for 14 days after last day of contact with COVID-19 positive person (or per Public Health guidelines)
- IF SYMPTOMS:
 - o It has been 10 days since symptoms first appeared AND o Symptoms have improved AND o 24 hours fever-free with no fever reducing medicine o IF diagnosed with OTHER illness (i.e.
 - Strep) also follow provider instructions specific to that illness (Need Provider note)

NO KNOWN EXPOSURE – (Sent home due to symptoms/illness) o May return to school when the following are met:

TEST NEGATIVE FOR COVID

- · All:
- o 24 hours fever-free without fever reducing medication
- o Symptoms have improved
- o <u>IF diagnosed</u> with OTHER illness (i.e. Strep) also follow provider instructions specific to that illness (Need Provider note)
- Proof of NEGATIVE COVID test. (SEE OPTIONS BELOW)
- <u>Test result is only accurate for the date</u> you were tested

NOT TESTED FOR COVID

- <u>All:</u>
- o It has been 10 days since symptoms first appeared **AND**
- o Symptoms have improved AND
- o 24 hours fever-free with no fever reducing medicine
- o <u>IF diagnosed</u> with OTHER illness (i.e. Strep) –also follow provider instructions specific to that illness (Need Provider note)

Physician note will not be provided for COVID test results. Obtain a copy of results by one of the following methods:
